Information for swimmers who organise their own boat

1. Race entry with your own boat will be confirmed only after the Sri Chinmoy Marathon Team **has received a picture of the boat and has approved of it.**
2. There must be enough space in the boat to take the swimmer on board.

*These boats are ideal, but a
LICENSE IS NEEDED*

Basically, boats need a ship identity card and a license plate. This includes the following types:

- Rowing boats that are longer than 2.50m as well as boats with a combustion or electric engine, for example:



If you bring a boat from abroad that needs a license plate in Switzerland according to the conditions above. please note:

- The boat has to get registered in time at the Swiss Navy and the owner has to bring it there (Oberrieden) on a weekday for inspection. If all the conditions are fulfilled, a license for 1-2 months will be issued (fee: ca. CHF 80.-)

- Rowing boats that are shorter than 2.50 m
- Kayaks (can be longer than 2.50 m)

Kajaks for 2 persons are a good solution for soloswimmers, especially if you come from outside of Switzerland. Kayaks do not need a license. Important: **There must be enough space in the Kayak to take the swimmer on board.**

All **rowing boats** around the lake of Zurich and all **motorboats from “Hensa”** in Rapperswil will be booked by the **Sri Chinmoy Marathon Team** and will therefore not be accepted as boats for “swimmers who organise their own boat”.
